The Definition of a Healthy Church

A healthy church is a Spirit-empowered community of disciples following Jesus, fulfilling his mission.

A healthy church is one that . . .

- Pursues and obeys God passionately
- Engages and maintains loving relationships
- Develops and mobilizes its people
- Acts with clear direction and outward focus
- Reproduces and multiplies His mission in other people and places

This definition encompasses 12 different evidences of a healthy church. Our goal is to identify as many objective measures that can be used to indicate effectiveness and progress toward the goal of becoming a healthy church.
